INQUIRY AND INNOVATION IN SCIENCE



At Dwight Global, our science labs blend live, hands-on activities with advanced simulations to foster engaged, curious, critical-thinkers. Many of our live labs can be performed with common household items, making science accessible for students at home. Additionally, during our in-person STEAM weekend event, students complete a number of live labs, where they practice essential skills and observe scientific phenomena firsthand.

A pioneer in adopting Virtual Reality (VR) in the K-12 educational landscape, Dwight Global is revolutionizing how students engage with science. Curated by faculty, VR labs provide an immersive and interactive environment with two modes of participation: a single-user play mode that supports mastery-based learning and individual practice, and a collaborative group mode, fostering critical skills such as communication and teamwork alongside scientific practical skills.



EXTRACURRICULARS

By creating spaces for students to connect and thrive beyond academics, Dwight Global fosters holistic student development, leadership, collaboration and global engagement with over 35 clubs and extracurriculars. Dwight Global offers two very rigorous paths for students: our AP and IB curriculums. Given that IB students and AP students are now assessed on two different grading scales, we have decided to no longer report official GPAs on our transcripts. We also do not report GPA distributions given the unique nature of each curriculum and the diversity of our student body. Students may enter Dwight Global throughout their high school journey, including senior year.

Grade Reporting

- Dwight Global does not add weight to any courses nor does Dwight Global report an official GPA on transcripts.
- The Class of 2025 IB Cohort now will be assessed based on the 1-7 IB scale to better reflect their progress within the IB curriculum. Dwight Global does utilize progressive grading. We also provide a 1-100 conversion scale on our transcripts.
